

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- **Category-A: Distance Education Overview**

Q1: What is distance education?

A: Distance education is a mode of learning where students can access quality education remotely without the need for physical attendance in classrooms.

Q2: What programs are offered through CDOE at SGVU?

A: SGVU offers UG, PG, programs in various fields such as Management, Commerce, Computer Science, and Humanities. The list of the programs is available on our website.

Q3: Is SGVU's CDOE recognized by UGC?

A: Yes, the Centre for Distance and Online Education at SGVU is approved by UGC-DEB. The approval letters are available on our website.

Q4: Is SGVU accredited by NAAC?

A: Yes, SGVU is accredited by NAAC with an "A+" grade, ensuring the quality of education provided. The NAAC certificate is available on our website.

Q5: What is the difference between distance education and online education?

A: Distance education uses offline and online materials for self-paced learning, while online education typically involves real-time virtual classes.

- **Category-B: Admission Process**

Q6: How do I apply for a course at SGVU CDOE?

A: Visit the SGVU CDOE website, choose your program, fill out the application form, upload documents, and pay the admission fee.

Q7: What documents are required for admission?

A: You'll need 10th and 12th marksheets, graduation marksheets (for PG courses), ID proof, and a passport-sized photograph.

Q8: Is there an entrance exam for admission?

A: No, admissions are based on your previous academic qualifications.

Q9: Can I apply for multiple programs simultaneously?

A: No, you can only enroll in one program at a time.

Q10: Is there a specific admission period for distance courses?

A: Admission queries are handled throughout the year but there are deadlines - based on the cut-off dates - which are as per UGC-DEB guidelines.

- **Category- C: Course Structure and Pedagogy**

Q11: What is the mode of instruction for distance education courses?

A: Instruction is delivered through self-learning materials (SLM), videos, and recorded lectures.

Q12: Are there any live classes?

A: Depends! some courses may include additional video / virtual classes to enhance learning. SLM is provided in each course.

Q13: What kind of study material is provided?

A: You'll receive SLM in the form of books, video tutorials, and access to LMS.

Q14: Are projects or internships mandatory?

A: This depends on the program; for example, MBA students must complete a project.

Q15: How are practicals conducted for science-related programs?

A: Practical are conducted through virtual labs, simulations, and occasional in-person sessions if required.

- **Category-D: Examination and Assessment**

Q16: How are exams conducted in distance education?

A: Exams are conducted at SGVU Main campus based on UGC-DEB guidelines.

Q17: What is the schedule for exams?

A: Exams are typically held at the end of each semester. Exact dates will be communicated through the student portal and also displayed in our academic calendar.

Q18: What is the duration of exams?

A: Exams usually last 2 to 3 hours depending on the course.

Q19: Can I choose my examination center?

A: No. We have only one examination centre - as our main campus - Suresh Gyan Vihar University Jaipur only.

Q20: How are results declared?

A: Results are published online on the student portal.

- **Category-D: Credit Transfer and Frameworks**

Q21: Can I transfer credits from NPTEL or SWAYAM courses?

A: Yes, SGVU allows credit transfer from NPTEL/SWAYAM as per UGC guidelines.

Q22: How are credits from SWAYAM evaluated?

A: SWAYAM credits are mapped to SGVU programs based on relevance and UGC-DEB norms.

Q23: What is the National Credit Framework; Credits are transferred to ABC?

A: NQF is a system that standardizes credit accumulation and transfer across institutions in India. Credits are transferred to Academic Bank of Credit (ABC). You will be guided about how to create your ABC ID and DEB ID.

Q24: Is credit transfer possible for incomplete programs from other universities?

A: Yes, you may apply for credit transfer after evaluation of your transcripts.

Q25: What is the maximum credit transfer limit?

A: Typically, up to 10% of total credits can be transferred from Swayam / NPTEL or other approved courses as per UGC-DEB regulations.

- **Category-E: Fees and Financial Assistance**

Q26: What is the fee structure for distance education programs?

A: Fees vary by program. Detailed information is available on the SGVU CDOE website.

Q27: Are there any scholarships for distance education students?

A: Yes, SGVU offers a few merit-based scholarships and discounts for certain categories.

Q28: Is there an option to pay fees in installments?

A: Yes, students can pay fees in installments as per the university's policies.

Q29: Are there any hidden charges?

A: No, all charges are mentioned clearly in the fee structure.

Q30: How do I get a refund if I withdraw from the course?

A: Refund policies are outlined in the admission guidelines; usually, refunds are provided within a stipulated period after deduction of processing fees.

A: In most cases, digital SLMs are provided through the LMS, but printed copies can be requested for specific programs.

A: Yes, SLMs are reviewed and updated regularly to incorporate the latest developments in the field.

Q60: How do I clarify doubts while studying SLMs?

A: You can use discussion forums on the LMS or contact faculty via email or scheduled virtual classes.
